



# RIVER PROUD



Charleston's 'River Proud' Program is an initiative of the Charleston Stormwater Department to recognize the citizens of Charleston who take action to reduce stormwater runoff and pollution by successfully managing the water on their property.

## Qualifying Properties:

- 1 acre or less
- Within the city limits of Charleston
- Residence or Business

Properties that wish to be considered for the award may submit the entry form on the back of this brochure or on our website; [charlestonstormwater.org](http://charlestonstormwater.org).

Applicants receive a property stormwater assessment, a homeowners guide to stormwater and a plaque that identifies their property as one of three water conservation tiers: Silver, Gold or Platinum. Property owners may work their way up from one level to another.

## WATER CONSERVATION TIERS

### Silver ★

At least one stormwater management solution has been utilized for managing and or harvesting rain water on a daily basis.

### Gold ★

A gold level property has incorporated more than one stormwater runoff solution and embraced the natural slope/drainage of the land as a management tool.

### Platinum ★

A platinum level property has not only incorporated the characteristics of the Silver and Gold levels, but has used water management techniques that are one of a kind or of a dual purpose. For example: an art piece that is also a rain catchment solution.
